Your tour starts on 5 November the day before you start your tour. All passengers have been booked into the Novatel Hotel at Tullamarine where an early evening meet and greet function as been arranged giving you the opportunity to meet your fellow passengers, tour staff and our flight crew.

Day 1 – 6 November

Today we have a departure time of 9:30am for the 3 hour flight to Christchurch, with an estimated arrival time around 2:30pm.

When you have cleared customs and immigration transport will be waiting to take you to the Fable Terrace Downs Resort., which is just over an hour from the airport. After checking in at the resort, the group will meet for drinks around 5:30pm followed by dinner at the resort restaurant.

Day 2 – 7 November

Fable Terrace Downs Resort offers golfers the opportunity to play a unique high country 18-hole championship golf course. The rewarding par 72 course designed by Sid Puddicombe offers a choice of four tees on each hole. The spectacular views pose a constant challenge for players to keep their eye on the ball!

Day 3 – 8 November

This a free day to explore some of the resorts activities, which the resort offers beyond golf, soak up the exquisite views or hone a new skill! A myriad of activities are at your doorstep from archery to clay bird shooting, walking trails, hunting or fishing and the natural wonders of the region.

Day 4 – 9 November

We have organised a round of golf at the Clearwater Golf Club in Christchurch. The Clearwater Golf Course has 18 magnificent holes, with 6 tee choices, flow through manicured greens and fairways, offering a golfing escape that few destinations can match. The club has hosted international professional golf for 13 consecutive years and look forward to providing you with the same rewarding experience.

Drinks and dinner have been arranged at the club.

Day 5 – 10 November

After breakfast, transport will take you to Christchurch Airport where you will board your private jet for the one hour flight to Auckland. Where transport will be waiting to take you to the Park Hyatt Hotel, the remainder of the days is free for you to explore the city.

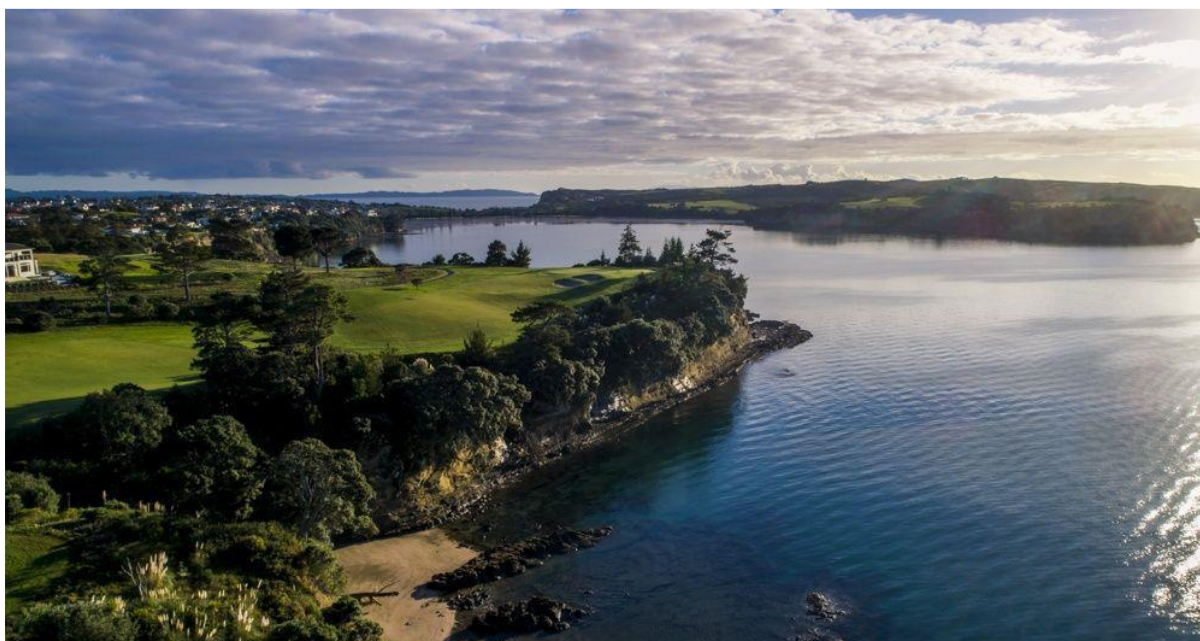


Day 6 – 11 November

Day 7 – 12 November

Today is a rest day from golf and we have arranged for you to visit the Auckland Sky Tower. The Sky Tower is one of the city's most popular attractions, especially for first-time visitors. Your visit has been rep-arranged avoiding the lines of visitors allowing you to visit the observation decks. Here you get quickly orientated and easily spot the key landmarks of the Harbour Bridge, Mount Eden, and Waiheke Island.

After your visit to the Auckland Sky Tower, we have arranged for a 2 hour cruise around the harbour where lunch will be served onboard. Dinner tonight will be at the Sidart restaurant, the owner and executive chef Lesley Chandra and his team use the seasons and availability to inspire the ever-changing menu. After breakfast transport will take you to the Natadola Golf Club, where you can enjoy a round of golf and lunch at the club's restaurant.

Day 10 – 15 November

The Natadola Bay Championship Golf, which has been booked for a day of golf. In October 2016 owners Natadola Bay Resort Limited re-invested in the course by bringing original designer, former World No.1 and Fiji golfing legend Vijay Singh back in to make a few changes.

With world renowned golf architect Greg Letsche, they went about making changes to 10 of the 18 holes, the sole purpose of these changes is to make Natadola Bay a fairer course, whilst maintaining the integrity of the venue and ensuring it will test all golfers the golf course is open daily to players of all levels.

Natadola Bay blends world class golf architecture with dramatic landscapes from rolling pastures through to absolute beachfront. With the sparkling backdrop of coral reefs and the Pacific Ocean on 15 out of the 18 holes, keeping your concentration will certainly be a challenge!

Lunch has been arranged in the clubhouse which is styled in traditional South Pacific architecture and is the ultimate vantage point for breathtaking views across the golf course, coral reefs and rolling surf breaks.

Day 11 – 16 November

Today we can arrange another round of golf for you or there are other activities which can be arranged, whether water activities, shopping or relaxing by the pool.

There will be a group dinner tonight which will be held at the award-winning, signature restaurant, Navo, to Kama Lounge, perfect for taking in South Pacific sunsets and locally inspired cocktails, which celebrates the beauty and culinary spirit of Fiji.

Day 12 – 17 November

Today we leave FJIJ around 10:00am for the 5 hour flight to Melbourne arriving around 2:0pm local time.
