Natadola Bay Championship Golf Course blends world-class golf architecture with dramatic tropical landscapes, from lush rolling pastures to absolute beachfront greens. You will enjoy the sparkling backdrop of coral reefs and the Pacific Ocean on 15 out of the 18 holes as you make your way around this astonishing course.

Inspired by traditional South Pacific architecture, the striking clubhouse is the ultimate vantage point for soaking up breathtaking views across the golf course to a string of coral reefs and rolling surf breaks – cap off the perfect round with a meal and a drink from the open-air bar and restaurant.

Measuring 6,566 metres from the championship tees, the par 72 championship standard golf course boasts up to five tee positions on each hole, providing an enjoyable challenge to players of all skill levels.

Natadola Bay Championship Golf Course was officially opened for play in June 2009 with the staging of the Fijian Open, won by then rookie professional Matt Griffin. The course has since hosted Fiji Open, Nomura Cup, Natadola Bay Fiji Classic and Fiji International tournaments.

After a round of golf cap off the perfect round with a meal and a drink from the open-air bar and restaurant.

There will be a group get together for drinks at 6pm followed by a casual dinner at the Toba Bar and Grill.

Day 3 – 6 December

There is no golf planned for today, instead we have arranged for you to sail the gorgeous South Sea Island nestled among the Mamanuca Islands. Just thirty minutes from Denarau, explore crystal waters, coral reefs, and swim among the colourful tropical fish.

Adventure comes to you with access to water sport equipment, dance performances, and a subsea adventure in the semi-submersible coral viewer. Indulge in the included lunch, alcoholic beverages, and bottled water. The perfect opportunity to relax and experience the best of Fiji.

Day 4 – 7 December

Today you get to play a round of golf at Denarau Island golf course. This course has breathtaking scenery, signature holes and championship-calibre course designs, attracting golfers of every level from around the world. This course was designed by Mr Eiichi Motohashi of Pannya Planning, Japan.

After successful round of golf, you will be ready for lunch which has been arranged at the Heineken House Restaurant & Bar. Choose from tempting delights at the Denarau golf club with menu offerings include an à la carte lunch or a special wood-fired pizza. The Denarau golf club restaurant features a sports lounge complete with live coverage of sports on a large-screen TV and a 360 degree bar serving ice cold beers!

No group dinner has been planned for tonight, you may want to explore other dinner venues at your leisure or chose one of the restaurants in the hotel for dinner.

Day 5 – 8 December

Today is a free day for you to relax by the pool or do some shopping, maybe you want to play another round of golf which your Tour Manager can arrange for you.

This is last night on the beautiful Island of Fiji before heading to New Zealand, drinks and dinner have been arranged at the Navo Restaurant in the hotel. The chic Navo Restaurant overlooks the lagoon and the unspoiled island of Navo.

Fine world wines complement modern specialities like Yasawas Island lobster kokoda and Natadola mud crab salad, all prepared in a glass show kitchen. Dinner is an enjoyable dining experience in this restaurant and an evening to share your experiences you have had on the golf courses over the last few days with your fellow travellers.

Day 6 – 9 December

Today we leave the hotel for the one hour drive to the airport where you will clear customs and board your private jet, with a planned departure from Fiji at 11:00am for the 3 hour and 30 minute flight to Wellington, New Zealand, arriving around 2:30pm.

After clearing customs and immigration transport will be waiting to take you to the intercontinental Hotel, which will take around 20 to 30 minutes depending on traffic.



Tonight, drinks and dinner has been arranged in one of the hotel's private dining rooms, where the tour manager will speak about the days ahead and arrangements for you play at different golf courses during your stay in Wellington.

Day 7 – 10 December

This morning after breakfast, transport will be waiting to take you to the Royal Wellington Golf Course makes the claim to be the home of New Zealand's best private members' parkland course. Situated alongside the Hutt River near Silverstream, the course offers an enjoyable and stimulating golfing challenge in a beautiful setting. Although Royal Wellington Golf Club is a private members' club, we have arranged for you to play the course.



Royal Wellington consists of two courses: the 18 hole championship Heretaunga Course and the nine-hole Terrace Course. The former is the recently opened (2014) redesign by Greg Turner and Scott Macpherson. The latter is composed mainly of holes that were part of the former championship course but not used for the redevelopment.

Lunch has been arranged at the club restaurant, following lunch transport will be waiting to take you back to your hotel.

This evening arrangements have been made for dinner at Pravada Café & Grill which is set in the heart of the city. In Russian, Pravda means “the truth”. Hence the eatery's focus on honest, produce-led dishes that use the very best ingredients New Zealand has to offer.

Pravda is Wellington's best steakhouse, with a carefully curated selection of exceptional cuts, informed by the menu at Pravda's siblings, the iconic Jervois Steak House restaurants. Executive chef Gavin Doyle sources red meat of the highest quality, and alongside the grill offering is a modern bistro menu, with dishes that offer something for everyone.

Day 8 – 11 December

Today we have arranged a relaxing day with a visit to the Martinborough Wine district with gorgeous scenery on a full-day group tour from Wellington to Martinborough. The tour also explores the Hutt Valley, Rimutaka Ranges, Wairarapa coast, and Lake Onoke.

You'll visit Martinborough wineries for cellar tours and tastings, pause for lunch in a vineyard restaurant, then eat dinner at the edge of Lake Onoke after a short shoreline hike. The tour includes a platter lunch, restaurant dinner, and a wine tasting.

Day 9 12 December

Today is you get to play a round of golf at Paraparaumu Golf course which is one of New Zealand's best golf courses and just a short 45 minute drive from Wellington CBD.

Regarded by many as one of the greatest links courses in the southern hemisphere, Paraparaumu Beach Golf Club is a world renowned layout on the undulating dune land of the Kapiti Coast. The course has hosted the New Zealand Open 12 times, a record unsurpassed by any other course. In 2002 it hosted the world's number 1 golfer, Tiger Woods.

Paraparaumu is a traditional links course and features a layout that will challenge the very best golfer, whilst allowing newcomers to the game plenty of scope for enjoyment.
